One of the longest running studies following people who inject drugs (PWID) in the world

>2500 PWID enrolled since 1996

Individuals complete a questionnaire, S loodwork & urine analysis



follow-up every
6 months



- Routinely collected data over time
- Data collected specific to new polies & intervention
